# **Test Name and Pricing**

#### A1C \$30.

This test gives the average blood sugar for the past 90 days, used to detect and manage diabetes.

#### Arthritis Profile \$80.

ANA, ASO, Rheumatoid Factor, ESR (Sedimentation Rate).

### Blood Group/Rh Type \$25.

ABO blood group (A, B, AB, O) and type (+ positive or - negative).

#### CA-125 \$50

May be used to look for early signs of ovarian cancer in those at high risk.

# Cardio CRP (High Sensitivity) \$50.

Helps determine relative risk of cardiovascular disease.

#### CK Total \$20.

Monitors the affects of certain medications, such as statin drugs. Increased levels may indicate myocardial infarction.

### Cortisol Total \$85.

The cortisol level may show problems with the adrenal glands or pituitary gland . Cortisol is made by the adrenal glands .

#### Ferritin \$40.

Lower than normal levels may help determine iron deficiency and anemia. Higher than normal levels could indicate liver disease, Rheumatoid Arthritis, and hyperthyroidism.

### Folic Acid (Folate) \$50.

Low folic acid levels may be the result of a primary vitamin B12 deficiency that decreases the ability of cells to take up folic acid.

#### FSH \$30.

Helps manage the menstrual cycle, used to diagnose menopause, ovarian cysts, abnormal bleeding. FSH is useful in the diagnosis and management of infertility, for this purpose blood draw should be on day 3 of cycle for ovulation.

## Hepatitis C Antibody \$45.

For past exposure and current Infection, many people can live with Hep C for decades with no symptoms.

## Homocysteine \$45.

High levels are linked to early development of heart disease. In fact, **high** levels of Homocysteine are a risk factor for heart disease and is associated with **low** levels of Vitamin **B12** and **Folate**.

### Iron/TIBC \$30.

Useful in confirming the diagnosis of iron-deficiency anemia or hemochromatosis (too much iron in the body).

# Lipid Panel (Coronary Risk) \$25.

Cholesterol Total, HDL, LDL, Triglycerides, Cholesterol/HDL Ratio.

#### Liver Function Test (Hepatic) \$30.

Total Protein, Albumin, Globulin (calculated), Albumin/Globulin Ratio (calculated), ALT, AST, Total Bilirubin, Direct Bilirubin, Indirect Bilirubin (calculated), Alkaline Phosphatase (GGT not in this panel).

#### Obstetric Panel (Prenatal) \$85.

Includes: Hepatitis B Surf. Antibody, Antibody Screen, Rubella Titer, Blood Group/Type, CBC, RPR/Syphilis

## Prothrombin Time (PT/INR) \$30.

Used to monitor Coumadin (Warfarin) medication.

#### PSA \$35.

Early detection of prostate cancer; recommended annually, (a suggested baseline for men at age 35).

#### STD Panel (Sexually Transmitted Disease) \$200.

Includes: (blood test) HIV 1&2, Herpes 1&2, Syphilis/RPR (Chlamydia and Gonorrhea-urine test)

**Testosterone Total \$70.** (Suggested baseline age 18 males) Detects testosterone levels in both men and women. Helps in diagnosing the following: Males: infertility, erectile dysfunction. Females: polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS)

# TSH (Thyroid Stimulating Hormone) \$35.

Useful in screening for hyperthyroidism and to evaluate thyroid function, mainly to see if it is underworking or overworking.

#### Free T3 \$50.

Used to diagnose hyperthyroidism and to clarify thyroid status in the presence of a possible protein binding abnormality.

### Free T4 \$25.

For diagnosis of hypothyroidism and hyperthyroidism. To find out how well your thyroid gland is working.

#### Vitamin B12 \$50.

Monitors an important vitamin for maintaining healthy nerve cells. B12 helps with cognitive deficits and emotional stability, promotes overall energy, and contributes to weight loss/control. Deficiency can lead to memory loss and other mental conditions.

# Vitamin D 25-Dihydroxy (OH) \$50.

Numerous studies have shown that many Americans have low vitamin D levels. Vitamin D has been shown to boost bone health and it may play a role in preventing diabetes, cancer, cardiovascular disease and other illnesses.
